

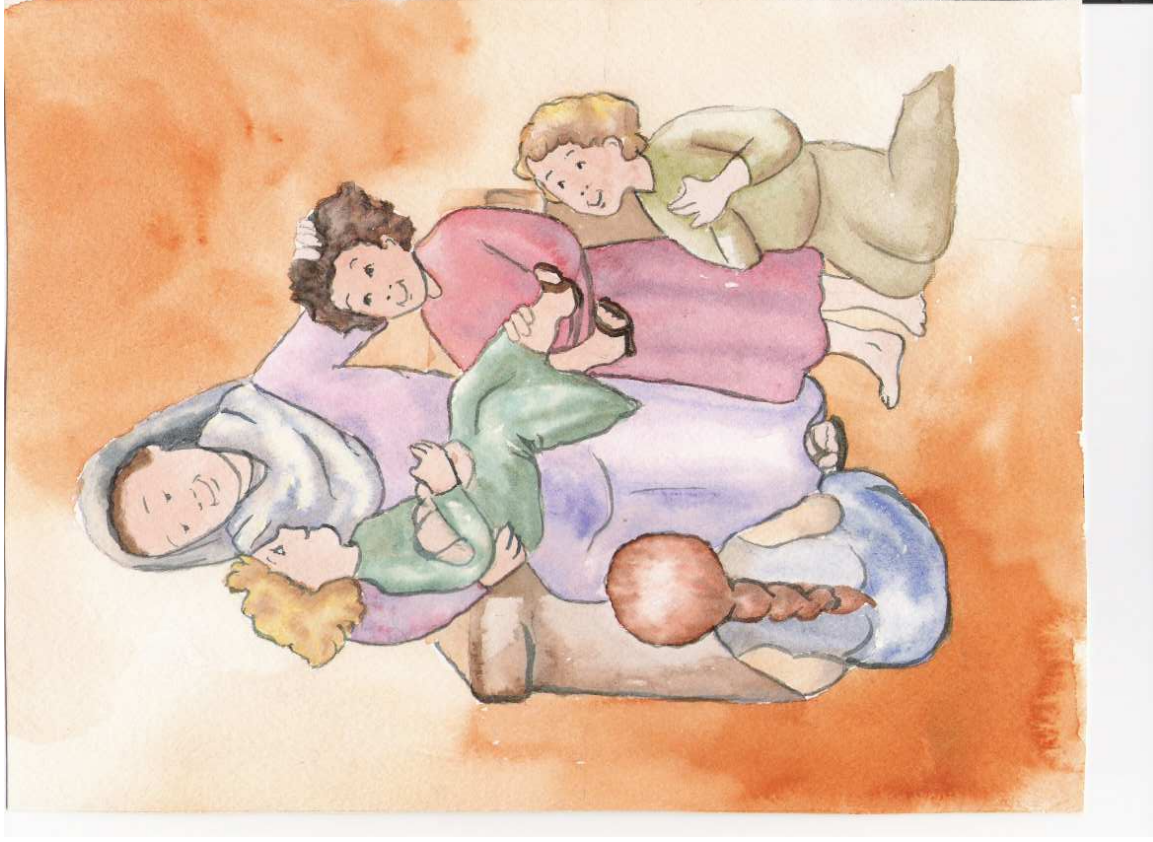

What was Jesus' reply? How does Jesus feel about children?

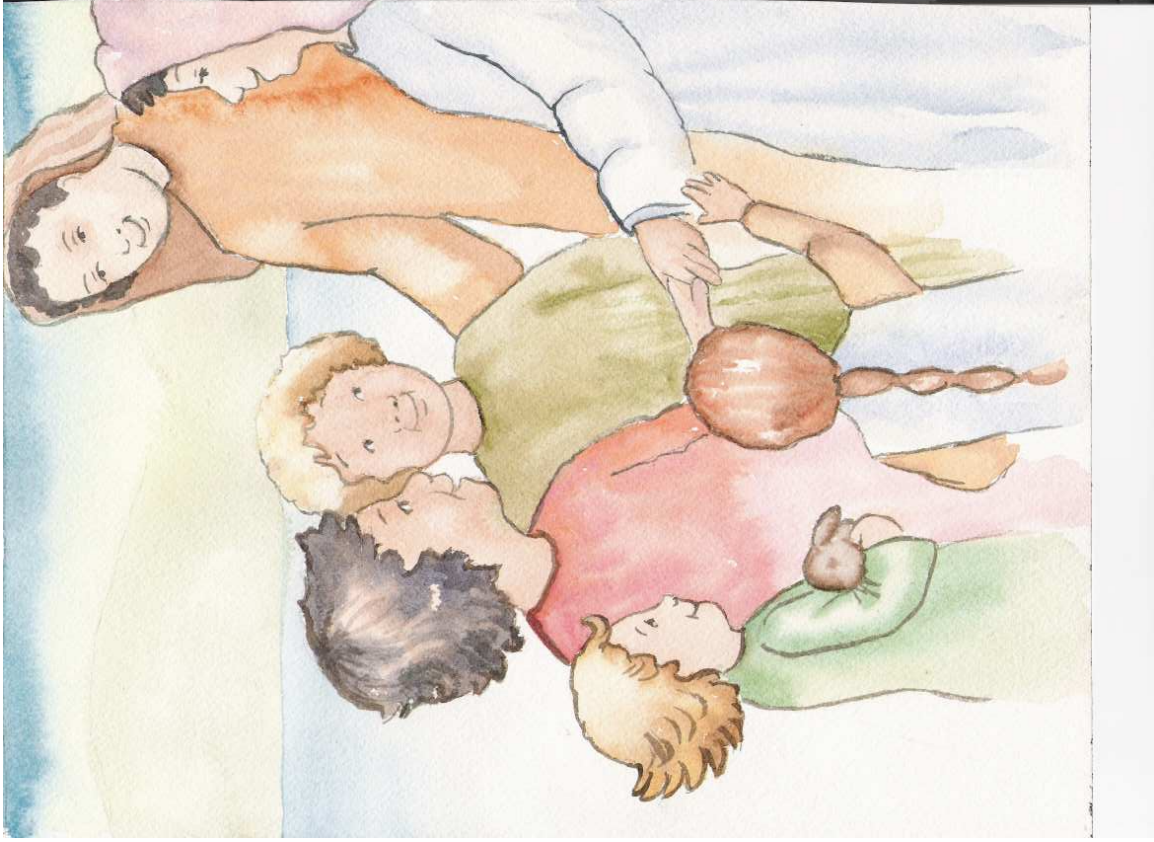
He was walking and talking to people about God.
