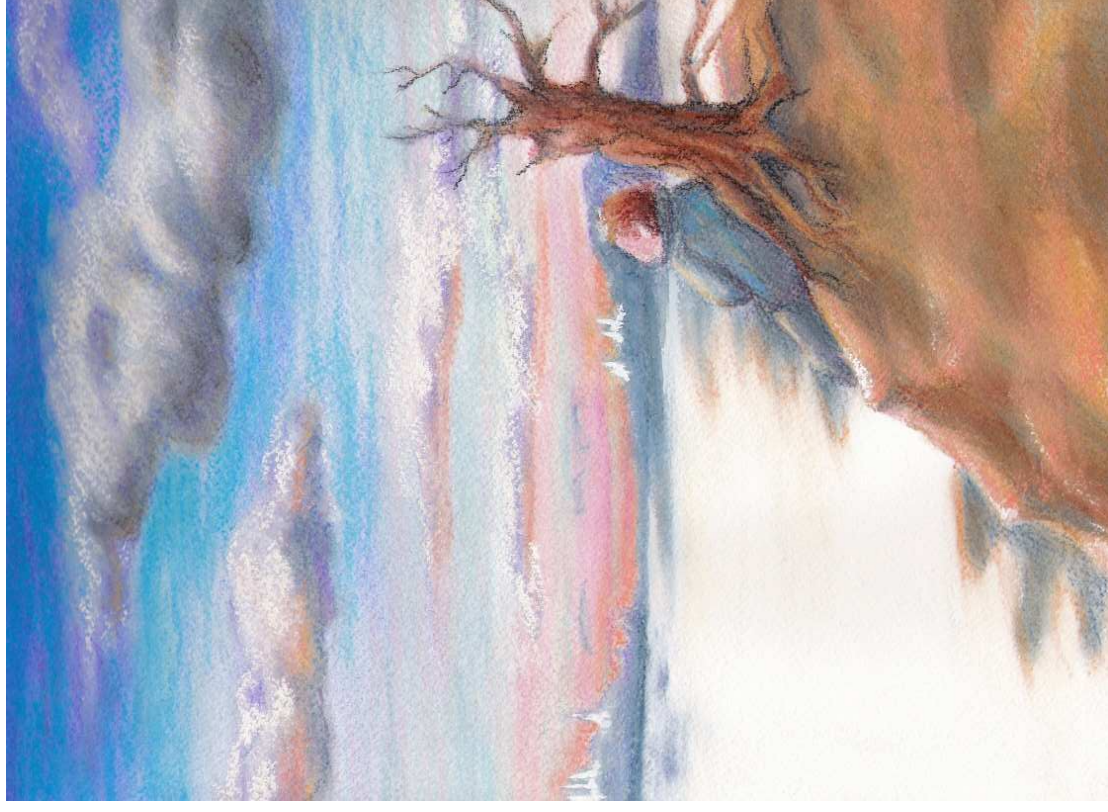

What is God's kingdom?

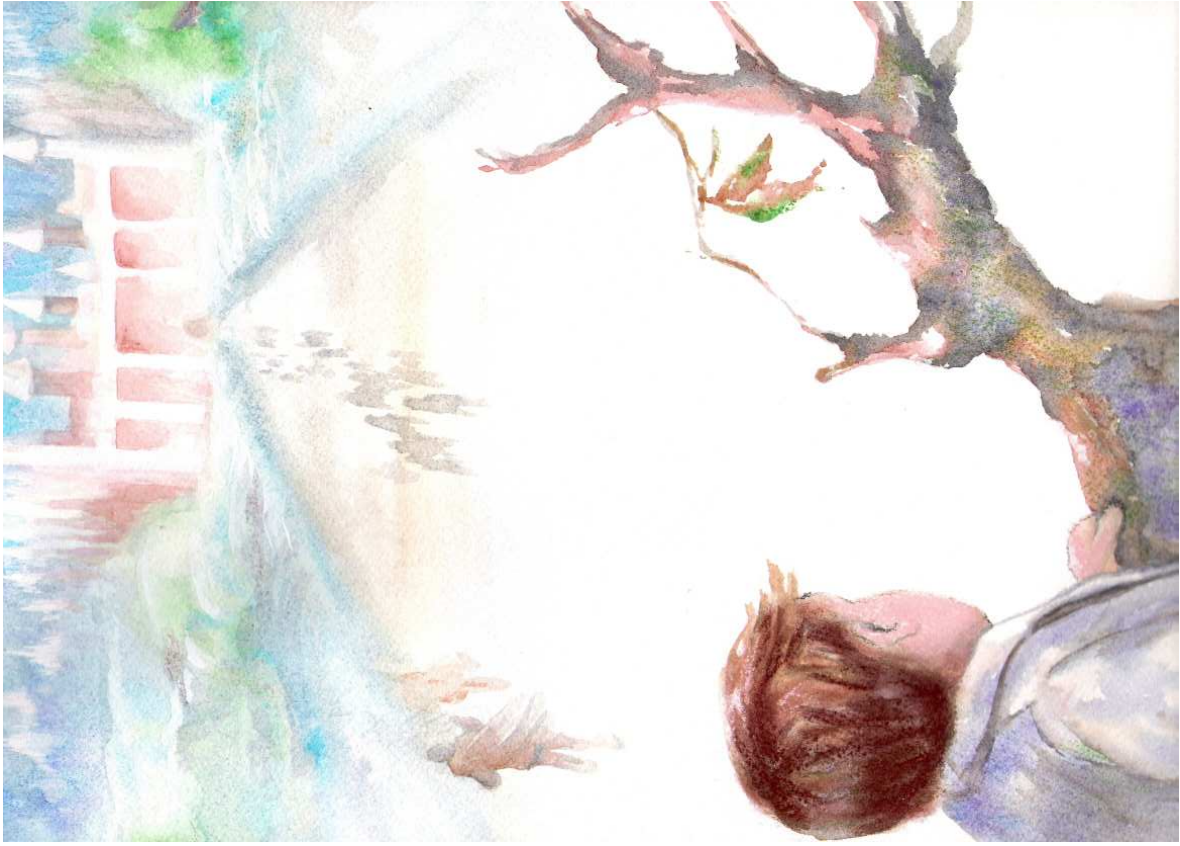
One day Jesus was talking to his disciples.

"We want to know how to pray," they said to him.

"Here is how you pray," he replied.

"First, you start by talking to God:

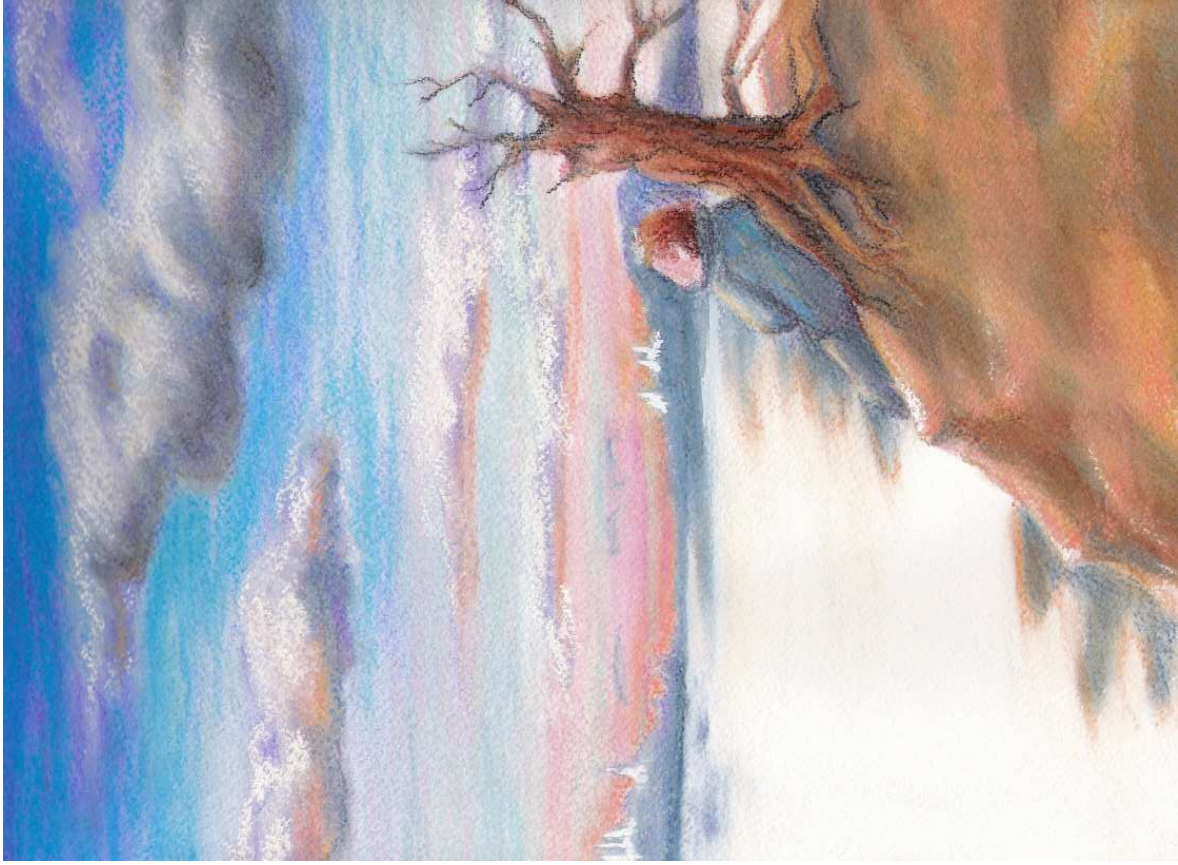
*Our Father who art in Heaven,
hallowed by thy name.*



Then you realize who God is and
thank him:

*For thine is the kingdom and the
power and the glory forever and ever,
amen.”*

That special prayer is called the
Lord's Prayer. It is how Jesus taught
us to pray.



Then you talk about what God
wants:

*Your kingdom come, Your will be
done, on earth as it is in heaven.*



Then you ask God to protect you:
*Lead us not into temptation but deliver us
from evil.*



Then you ask God to help you:

Give us this day our daily bread.



Then you ask God to forgive you:

*Forgive us our sins as we forgive
those who sin against us.*
