

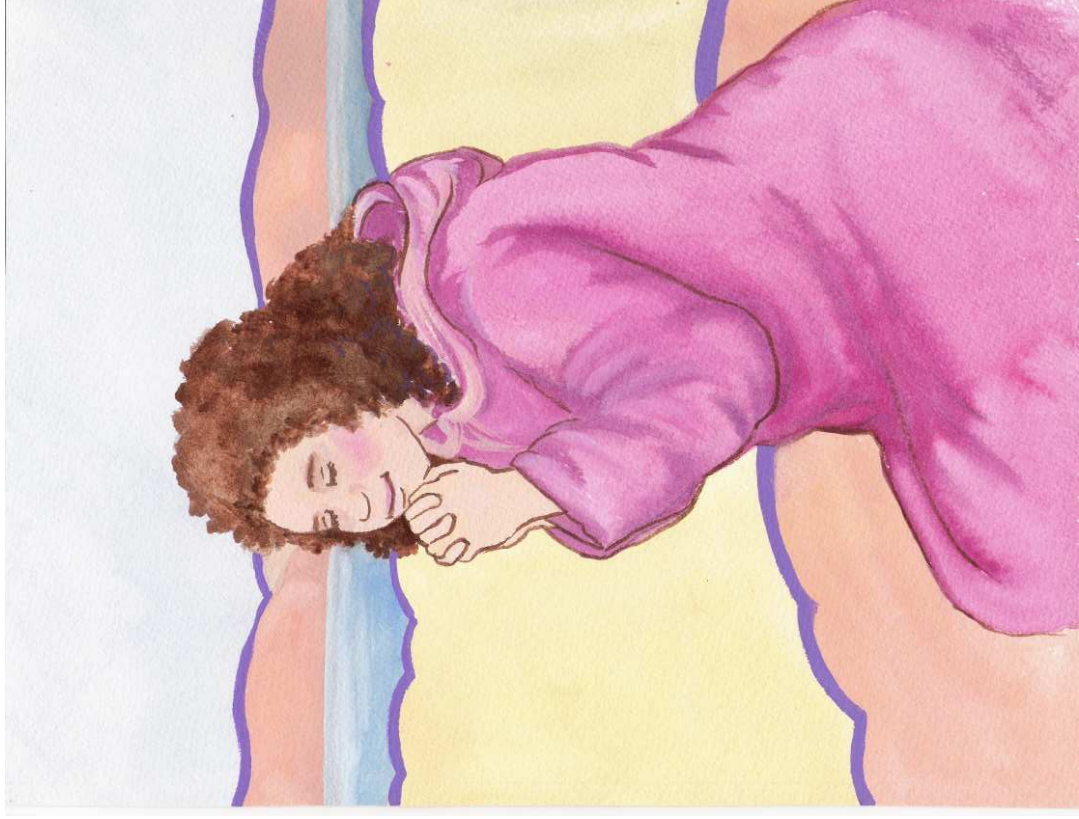

## Parent/child weekly study

Lydia was a young woman who lived many years ago. She sold purple cloth to make money. Lydia did not know about Jesus, but she did believe in God.

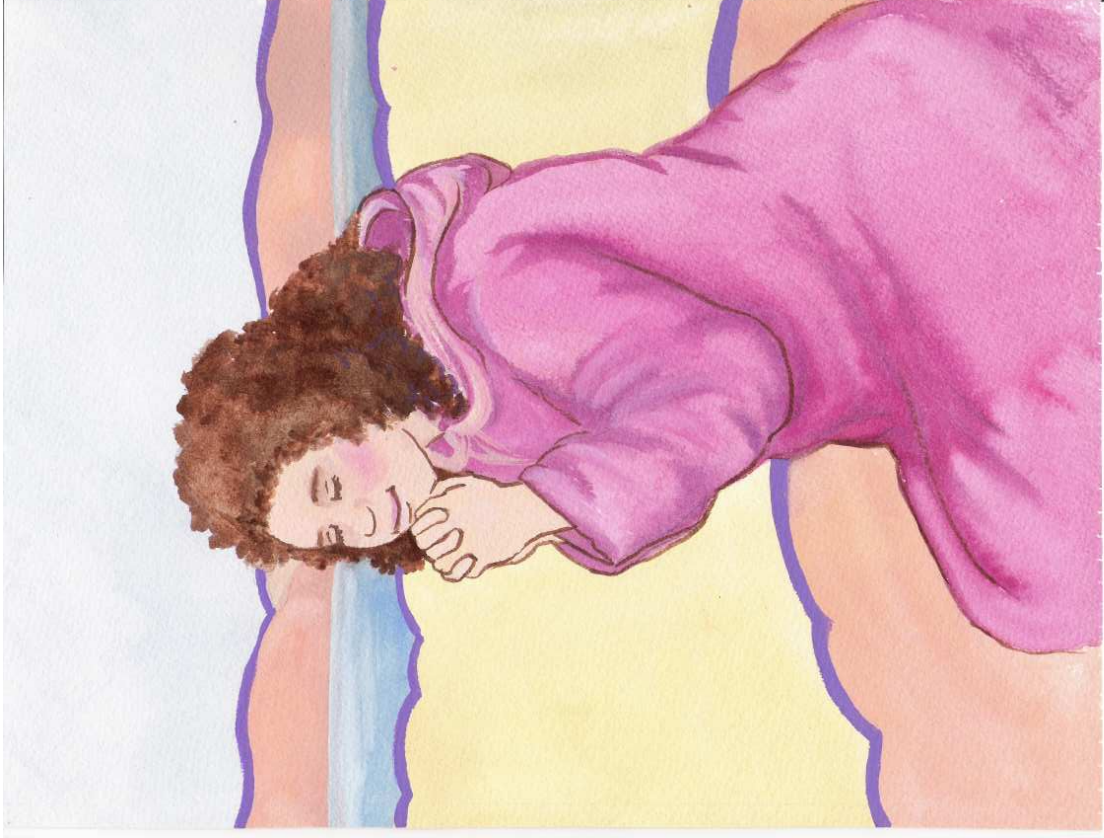
