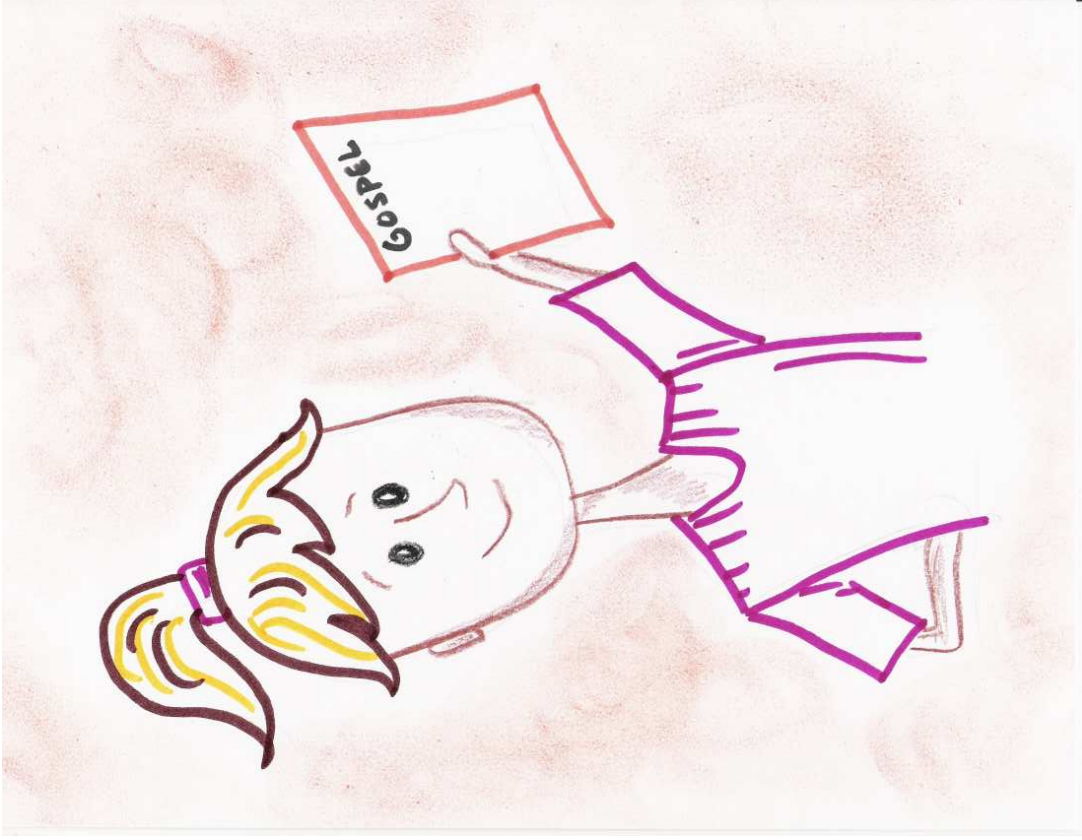

concluded.



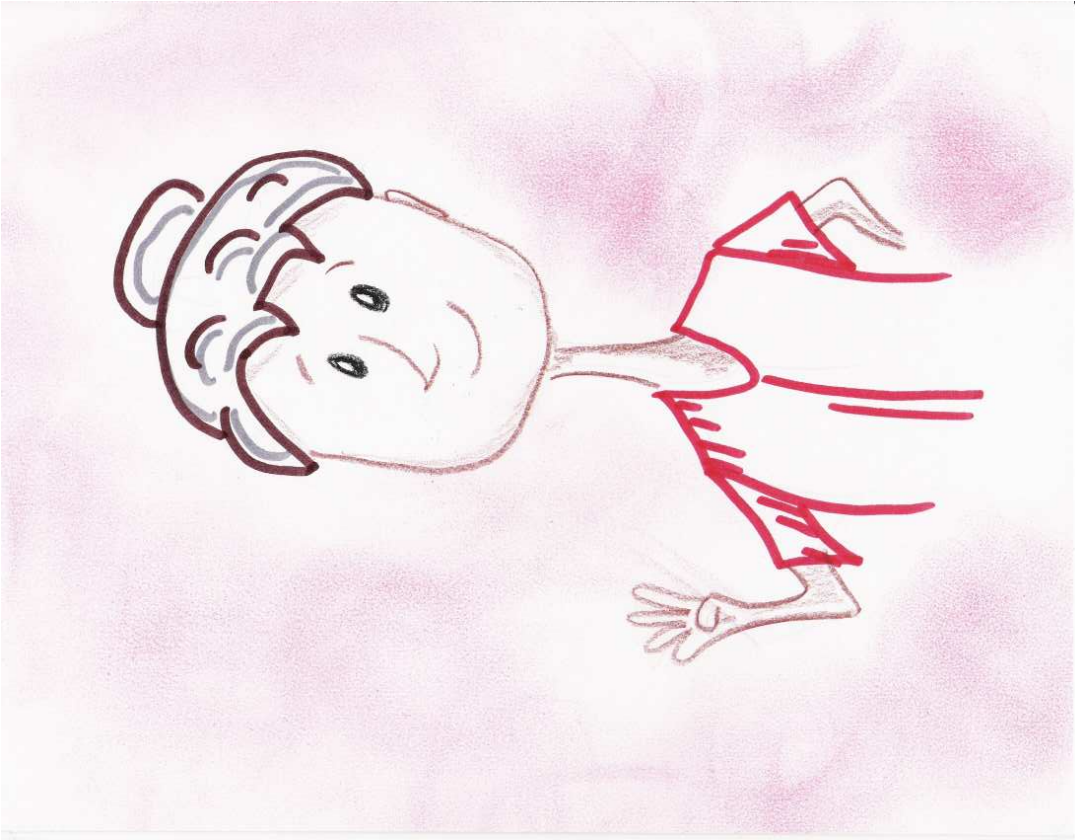
Janna was sitting at the kitchen table working on her letters.

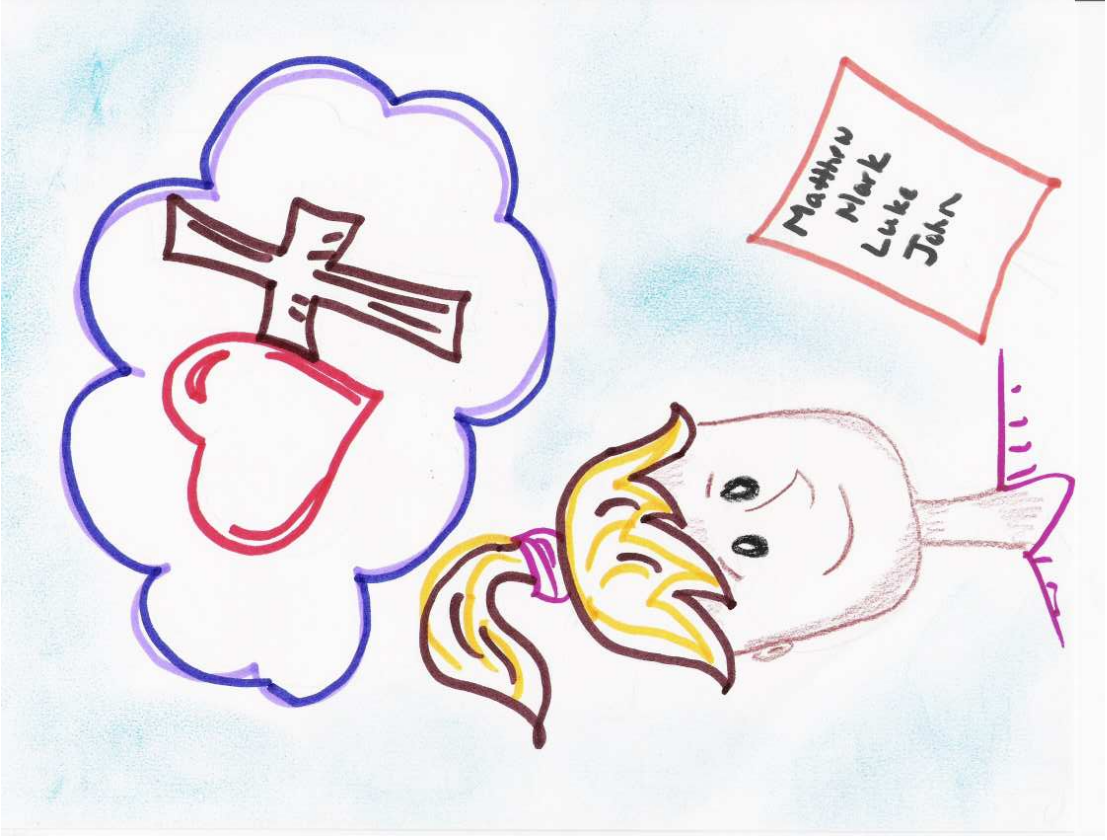
“G-O-S-P-E-L, that spells gospel,” she wrote with her pink pen.

“Most important, they tell us how much Jesus loves us.”

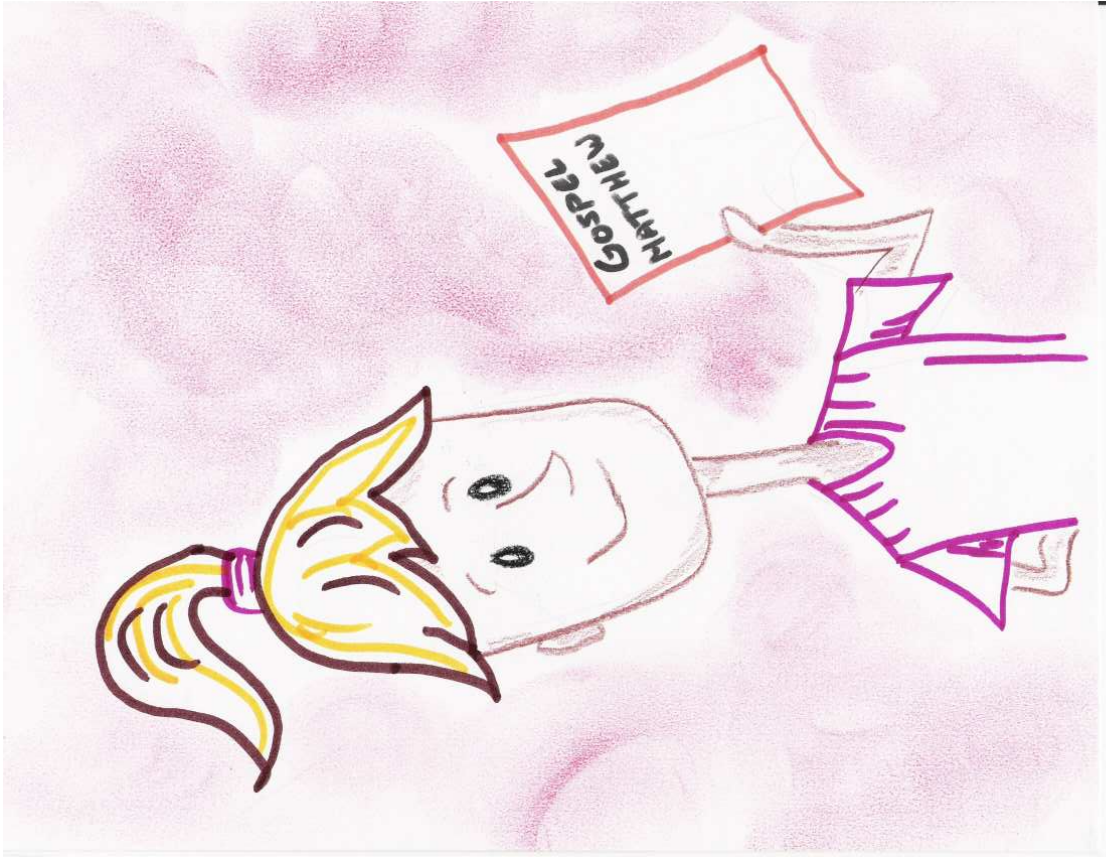




“What is a gospel?” She asked her mom who was writing in her journal.

“A gospel? Well, gospel means ‘good news,’ and there are four very special books in the Bible called gospels.

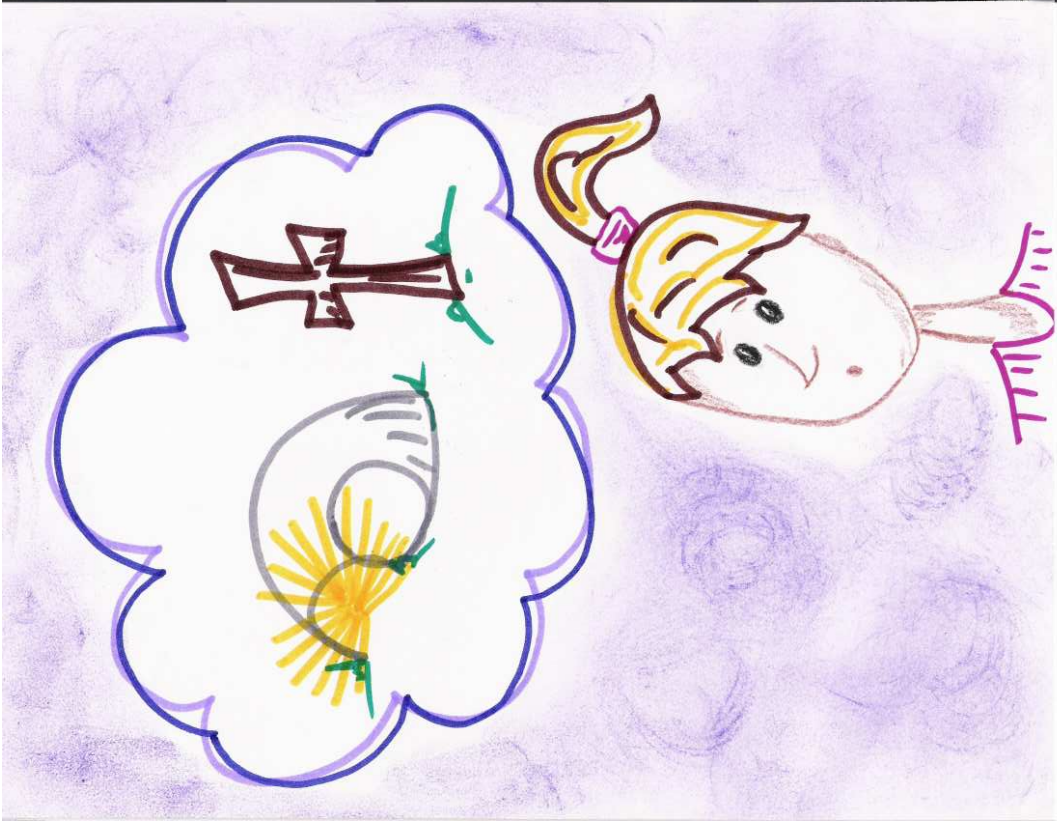
Their names are Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.”

L-U-K-E

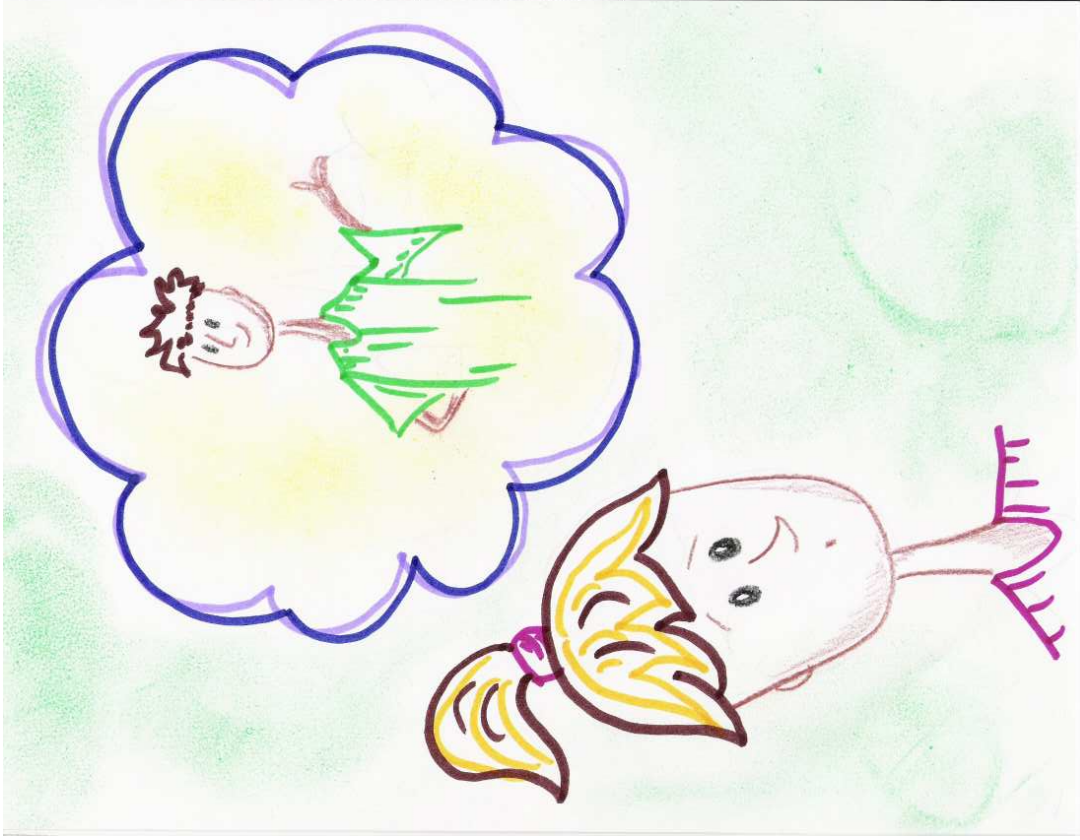
“They also tell us about how Jesus died, and then rose again.”
